

# HIGH SCHOOL GETS SUPPORT FOR SPORT

The Satterley Property Group and Smithfield State High School have teamed up to support the school's professional approach to its sports activities.

Satterley is underwriting the supply of sports uniforms to the school's 14 Inter-school sports teams. It will also supply outfits for the school's new cheerleading troupe of 16 girls and two boys.

The developer's contribution equates to a total of 148 shirts and singlets, 148 pairs of socks, 104 hats and caps and 14 staff shirts, as well as singlets, skirts, t-shirts and shorts for the 18 member cheerleading squad.

Greg said this new approach needed high quality uniforms to give the 14 teams conformity on the field - and that's where Satterley came in. According to Adam Gowlett, Queensland Manager for the Satterley Property Group, making the decision to partner the school was an easy choice.
