

## **BLOCK EXAM INSTRUCTIONS**

## **Student Instructions**

## School uniform, including footwear, must be worn to all exam sessions.

- 1. Carefully read the timetable, highlighting the exams/compulsory tutorial sessions you must attend.
- 2. Be at the exam room ten (10) minutes in advance of the exam session starting.
- 3. YOU are responsible for knowing WHEN your exam is on and WHERE it is.
- 4. Bags must be placed outside the classroom. ENSURE MOBILE PHONES ARE SWITCHED OFF. PERSONAL LISTENING DEVICES ARE NOT TO BE USED OR VISIBLE DURING EXAMS.
- 5. If your exam is not starting immediately, you should study **QUIETLY** as per supervising teacher's instructions.
- 6. Make sure you bring a **STAPLER** and extra pens, pencils, a ruler, eraser, paper and a calculator to your desk. **DO NOT** bring any other equipment into the room. Water bottles will be allowed in some rooms.
- 7. Once the exams start you cannot:
  - TALK OR COMMUNICATE IN ANY WAY, TO ANYONE, EXCEPT THE SUPERVISOR
  - BORROW EQUIPMENT
  - CHEAT OR PLAGIARISE
  - LEAVE THE EXAM ROOM BEFROE THE SESSION FINISHES, unless dismissed.
- 8. You will not be allowed to go to the toilet unless a teacher is available to accompany you. Go before the exam if you need to.
- 9. Once the exam starts, place your study books on the floor.
- 10. Talking or cheating during an exam will result in a referral to a HOD/Deputy Principal/Principal.
- 11. If you are absent from an exam, you will need a Doctor's Certificate to be given special consideration. You must present copies of this to the Head of Departments of subject exams you missed, and to the office or Guidance Officer.
- 12. Students must attend school for all scheduled exams/compulsory tutorial sessions.
- 13. If you do not have an exam scheduled for a session you can;
  - study or work on assignments at home
  - study or work on assignments in the school library
  - make an alternative arrangement with a teacher to study at school
